The interdisciplinary graduate program, developed in a cooperation of the universities of Kassel and Göttingen, seeks to explore the interactions between space and gender as they are constructed in present-day and historical societies both in and outside of Europe: "doing space while doing gender". The three areas of scholarly investigation will be the *dimensions of embodiment*, *dimensions of location*, and *dimensions of entanglement*. Of central interest will be questions of global and local phenomena when placed within the context of Gender Studies. The participating subjects are Arabic and Islamic Studies, English and Canadian Studies, Ethnology, German Studies, History, Medical Ethics and Medical History, Sociology, and Theology.

Applicants are expected to have a distinctly above-average degree and a doctoral project that exhibits an interest in interdisciplinary work. Further, they should be willing to have their place of residence in either Göttingen or Kassel. While the program's language is German, the internationality of both the visiting scholars and the research themes addressed requires participants to have a good knowledge and command of English. Dissertation projects will be supervised by the program's academic staff.

Potential candidates are asked to submit an informal application for admission into the graduate program, the customary supporting documents (curriculum vitae, grade records etc.), a five-page project exposé, a sample chapter of the Master's thesis (ca. 30 pages), and two letters of recommendation.

This position will be located at the University of Kassel.
