We announce the conference **Trans Dialogues on Work, Life and Resistance**, taking place online the **9th and 10th of July 2022**.

The conference is part of a wider effort to create alternative public spaces to learn about the realities of being trans and construct new understandings of trans politics. The dialogues are built around the notions of work, life and resistance to sustain a space for encounter across differences, emphasize global and intersectional complexities, challenging singular narratives and homogenizing constructs of trans people.

The conference is comprised of four regional conversations each of which brings together activists from local trans organizations in Buenos Aires, Managua, Singapore, Kuala Lumpur, Berlin and Nairobi. The speakers will discuss political, cultural and economic aspects affecting trans communities within the region. The conference will take place in English and Spanish with simultaneous translation.

The conference is for anyone who wants to learn about the issues shaping and affecting trans lives and politics. It aspires to create a space for cis, trans people and all other sexes and genders, for people who had to leave school as well as those who study or work in universities, for those fighting under the banner of LGBTIQ and feminism, against capitalism, racism, climate change, for economic and social justice towards a livable world.

The conference is a cooperation between the [Center for Interdisciplinary Women and Gender Studies](#) (ZIFG) and [International Women* Space](#) (IWS).

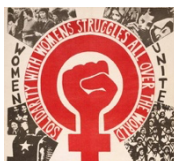
